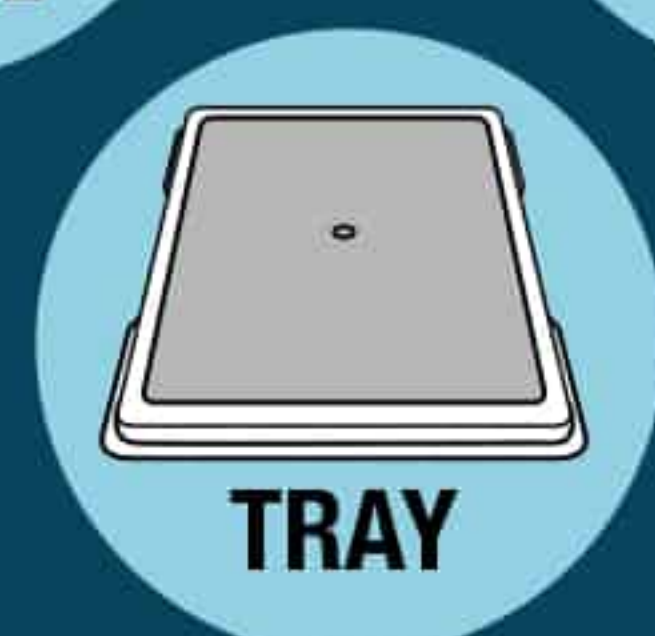

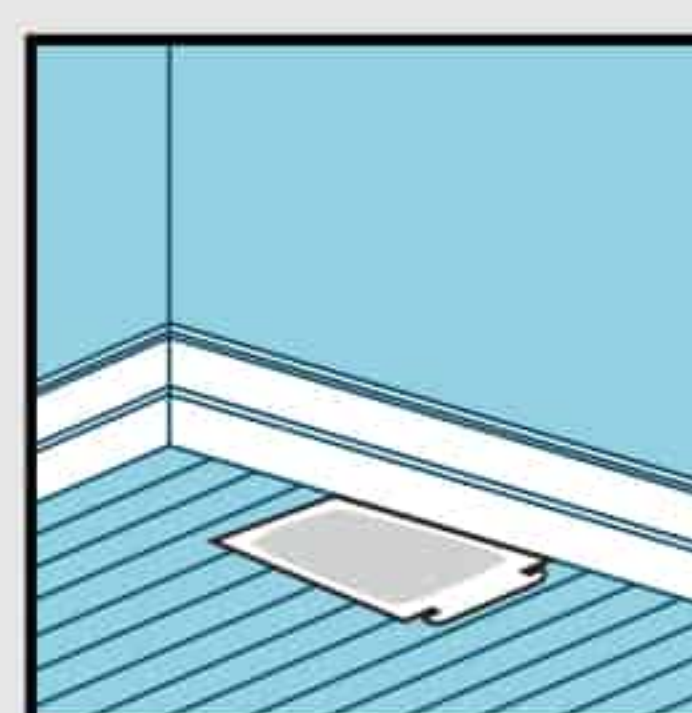

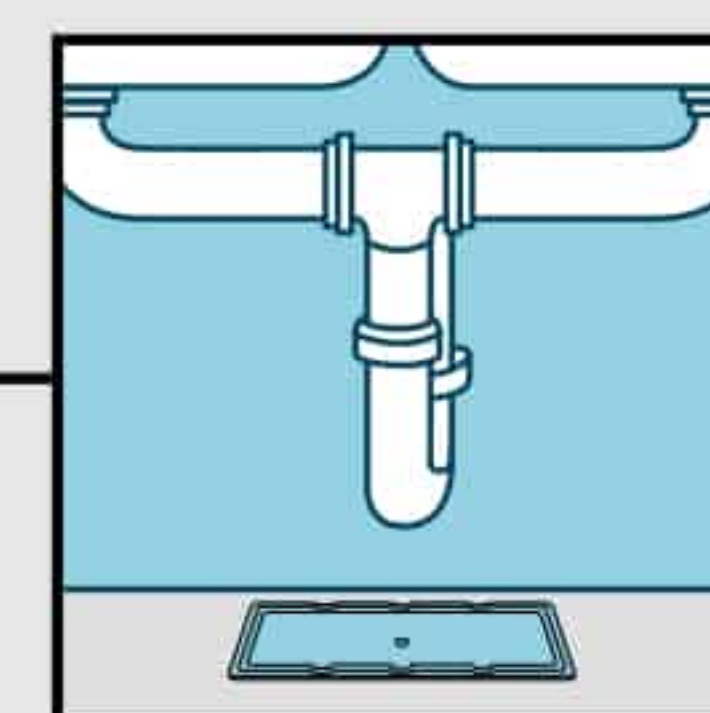

PROPER PLACEMENT

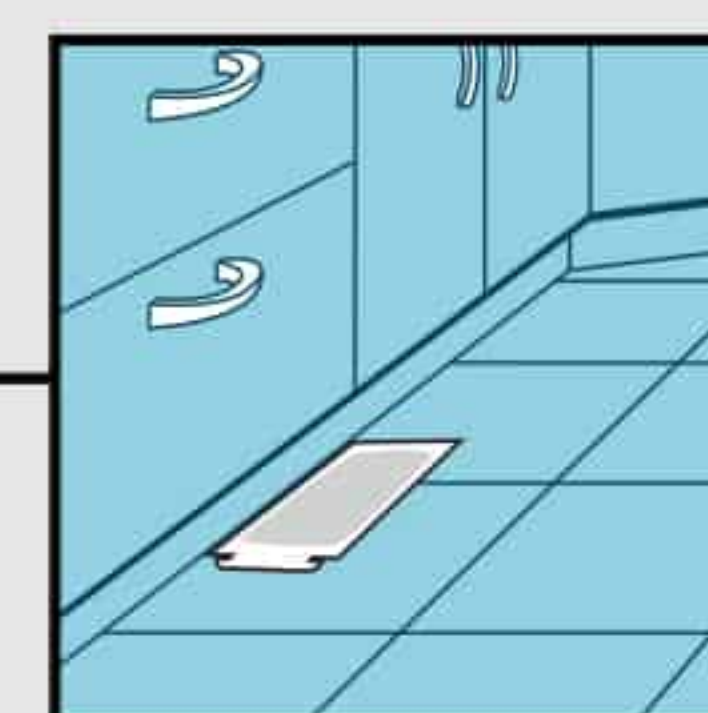
Place trap with **GLUE SIDE FACING UP:**



Along Baseboards

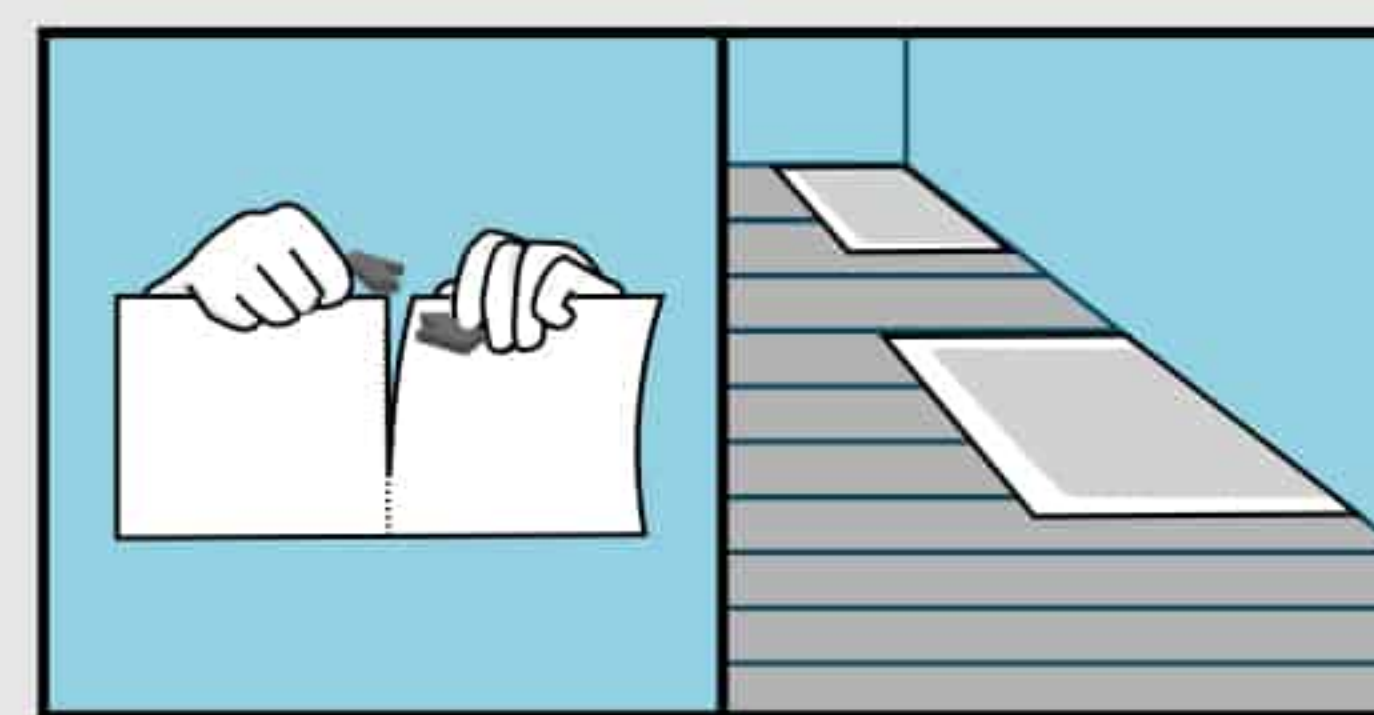


Under Sinks

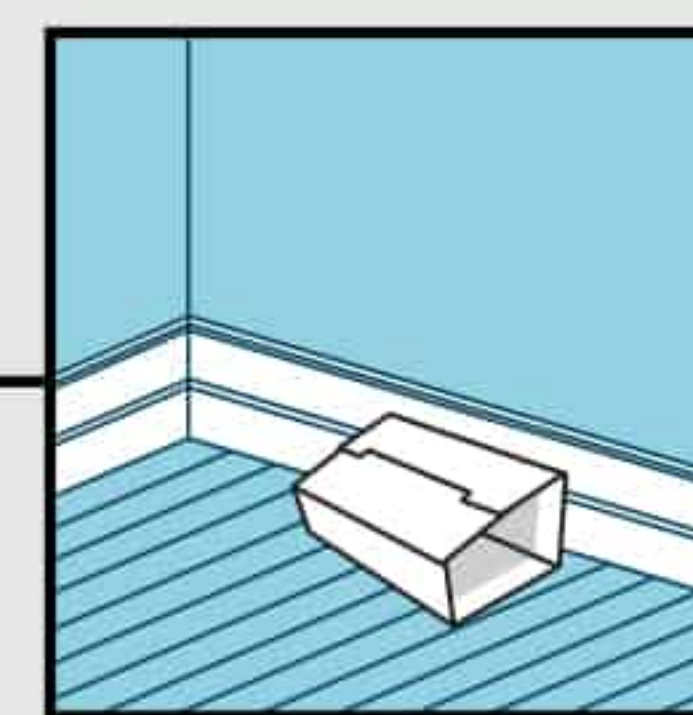


On Floors

Tips for **GLUE BOARD PLACEMENT:**

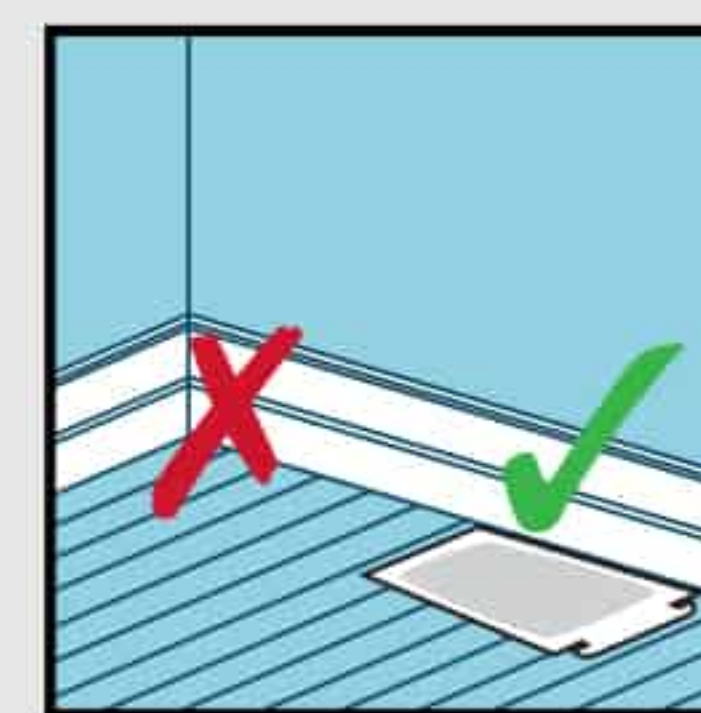


Fold along lengthwise
perforation and place
against wall to maximize
catch potential

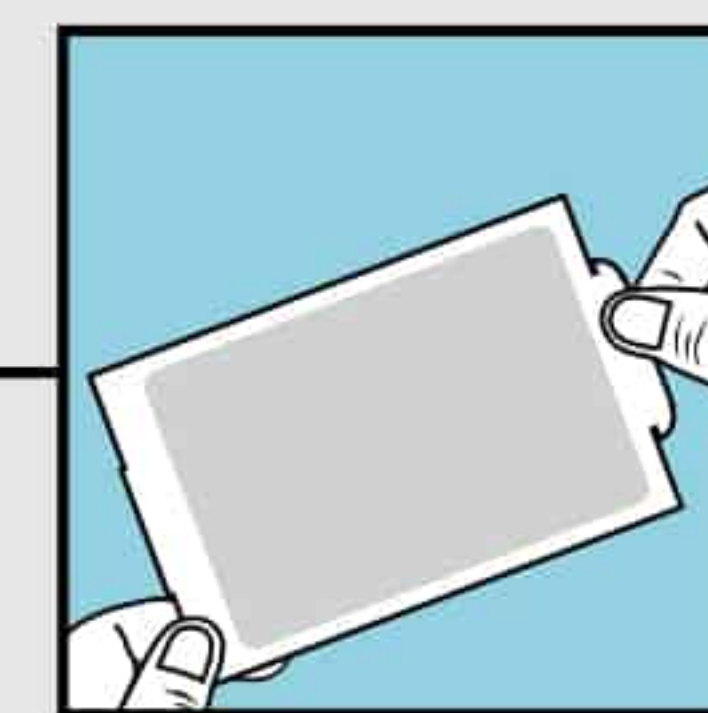


If using in a dusty
environment,
fold to create a tunnel

Tips for **RODENT TRAPPING:**



Place along pathways
like baseboards,
do not place in corners



Check traps daily
or when
noise is heard



BIG ED'S TRAPPING TIPS



- ★ The more the merrier – rodents and insects can be fickle, placing several traps will increase your likelihood of a catch
- ★ If you utilize a glue board leave it in the environment for a day or two before removing the release paper, this will allow for pests to acclimate to the trap
- ★ Glue boards and trays are monitors and will give you early warning for potential pest infestations
- ★ Thoroughly inspect your property and seal up any possible entrance points like cracks in foundations or gaps in doorways
