TOPDRESSING FOR INFIELDS CALCINED CLAY

PRESEASON INFIELD PREP

- 1. Ensure infield skin has been properly graded and compacted for positive run off.
- 2. Apply Platinum to your infield according to the Usage Table below based on your infield size and the depth of topdressing. Do not maintain more than 1/4" of topdressing on the surface of your infield skin.
- 3. Scarify or nail drag Platinum topdressing into top 1/4". Do not till as an amendment.
- 4. Finish drag for consistent coverage across infield skin.
- 5. Call 866-867-0052 with questions and more recommendations.

IN-SEASON DAILY MAINTENANCE

- 1. Maintain 1/4" coverage of Platinum on top surface.
- 2. Maintain even moisture throughout infield profile with heavy "flood watering" after last game.
- 3. Light nail drag in morning with proper moisture.
- 4. Finish mat drag and maintain even moisture until game time.
- 5. Add topdressing as needed to maintain consistent coverage.

WET FIELD CONDITIONS

- 1. Apply Platinum to wet areas and allow topdressing to absorb excess moisture.
- 2. Rake or drag smooth.
- 3. Remove excess the next day if topdressing exceeds 1/2".
