## CALCINED CLAY TOPDRESSING FOR INFIELDS

### ▶ PRESEASON INFIELD PREP

1. **Ensure infield skin** has been properly graded and compacted for positive run off.
2. **Apply Platinum** to your infield according to the *Usage Table* below based on your infield size and the depth of topdressing. *Do not maintain more than 1/4" of topdressing on the surface of your infield skin.*
3. **Scarify or nail drag** Platinum topdressing into top 1/4". *Do not till as an amendment.*
4. **Finish drag** for consistent coverage across infield skin.
5. **Call 866-867-0052** with questions and more recommendations.

### ▶ IN-SEASON DAILY MAINTENANCE

1. **Maintain 1/4"** coverage of Platinum on top surface.
2. **Maintain even moisture** throughout infield profile with heavy "flood watering" after last game.
3. **Light nail drag** in morning with proper moisture.
4. **Finish mat drag** and maintain even moisture until game time.
5. **Add topdressing as needed** to maintain consistent coverage.

### ▶ WET FIELD CONDITIONS

1. **Apply Platinum** to wet areas and allow topdressing to absorb excess moisture.
2. **Rake or drag smooth.**
3. **Remove excess** the next day if topdressing exceeds 1/2".
