Apply only as directed. Apply during the growing season.

General Information

This product is designed primarily for application in spray equipment. It can also be spread as a dry product using traditional rotary spreaders, but it is not optimized for dry spreading application.

This product may contain trace amounts of material that cannot be dissolved. Spray equipment sensitive to clogging may not be able to apply this product.

For all applications:

- Apply to dry foliage.
- Water in after application with a minimum of 0.2 inches to help move particles into the turf canopy.
- Do not collect clippings for at least one mowing following application to avoid particle pick-up.

Cool Season Grasses:

- Apply at the LOW or MEDIUM RATE.
- Apply at the LIGHT RATE when temperatures exceed 85°F.

Warm Season Grasses:

- Apply at the LOW to HIGH RATE every 4-6 weeks during the period of active growth.

Do not apply near water, storm drains or drainage ditches. Do not apply if heavy rain is expected. Apply this product only to your lawn and sweep any product that lands on the driveway, sidewalk or street, back onto your lawn.
